Photography Policy

St Mary Redcliffe Church will occasionally take photographs of children and their work during their school visits in order to keep a record of the visit and occasionally for promoting the Education Work.

However, we will:

- ask permission from the teaching staff during the workshop
- ask the child if they are happy for a photograph to be taken of them or of their work
- talk to the child involved about why their photograph is being taken and what the photograph might be used for
- as far as possible avoid taking photographs of children's faces or crop photographs so that faces do not appear.
- always ask permission from the school to use any photographs on the church website, in reports or other publicity material
- never use children's names in photograph captions on the church website, in reports or other publicity material
- never show children's work if it includes their name on the church website, in reports or other publicity material
- notify the school in advance if any additional photographs are likely to be taken for any purpose other than recording the event for the Education Work at St Mary Redcliffe Church
- ensure that visitors to the church are asked by the church stewards not to take photographs of the children during workshops and tours
